Brief summary of the content of the workshop	The workshop was aimed at discussing the format and the content of the portfolio PEPELINO. During the workshop the participants were sharing good practices in kindergarten, the existing curricula for pre-primary teacher education, strategies for implementing plurilingual education thus emphasising issues of cultural and plurilingual aspects of pre-primary teacher education. Also the role of reflection, reflection tools, such as portfolio for teachers, as well as how PEPELINO could be used in teachers' work and student-teachers' (in-service and pre-service) teaching practice were discussed and experiences shared through different activities.
What did you find particularly useful?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Teachers, especially pre-primary student-teachers need a personalised tool to reflect on their own training and teaching, and PEPELINO would be such a tool when fully developed and finished. • Fruitful and enriching sharing of experiences and discussions with colleagues from other countries. • Raising the awareness and topicality of integrating cultural and plurilingual aspects into pre-primary education.

<p>How will you use what you learnt/ developed in the event in your professional context?</p>	<p>The ideas from the portfolio/ parts of the portfolio can be already used with students to teach them reflection skills and create discussion about teaching methodology and student's progress in the course of study and teaching practice.</p> <p>I am looking forward to piloting stage of the portfolio. In my opinion, it will be a very significant tool of reflection/ self-assessment for pre-primary student-teachers.</p>

Seminārs "Eiropas portfolio studentiem - pirmsskolas izglītības pedagogiem"(European portfolio for student teachers of pre-primary education) Eiropas Moderno valodu centrā Grācā

Sintija Vaļka, Latvijas Universitātes, Pedagoģijas, psiholoģijas un mākslas fakultātes lektore.

Seminārs bija plānots ar uzdevumu kopā ar citiem 27 semināra dalībniekiem apspriest līdz šim darba grupas vadītāju izveidotā Eiropas portfolio studentiem – pirmsskolas izglītības pedagogiem (PEPELINO) melnraksta formātu un saturu. Portfolio tiek veidots kā instruments refleksijai, lai studenti, topošie un jau strādājošie pirmsskolas izglītības pedagogi, mācītos izvērtēt savas pedagoģiskās prasmes pirmsskolas bērnu mācīšanā, arī svešvalodu apguvē, un aktuālajā pirmsskolas skolēnu daudzvalodības un kultūras daudzvalodības izpratnes veicināšanas jautājumā.

Semināra laikā dalībnieki aktīvi piedalījās pieredzes apmaiņā saistībā ar pirmsskolas izglītības saturu, pirmsskolas skolotāju sagatavošanu, atrodot kopīgos un atšķirīgos aspektus. Tika daudz diskutēts par daudzvalodību sabiedrībā un izglītībā. Darba grupas vadītāji aktualizēja jautājumu par to, kad un cik lielā mērā kultūras un daudzvalodības aspekts tiek atspoguļots pirmsskolas izglītības saturā, kā tas izpaužas praksē.

Dalībniekiem aktīvi līdzdarbojoties, iepazīstoties ar projekta materiāliem un izvērtējot tos, tika secināts, ka Eiropas portfolio studentiem – pirmsskolas izglītības pedagogiem (PEPELINO) vēl nepieciešami papildinājumi un precīzējumi, lai jaunā mācību gada sākumā to varētu publicēt pilotēšanai un izmantošanai praksē.

Semināra dalībnieci lielākais ieguvums bija sadarbība un viedokļu apmaiņa ar dažādu institūciju pārstāvjiem no dažādām valstīm, kas ļāva iegūt jaunas zināšanas un pieredzi par pirmsskolas izglītības jautājumiem un pirmsskolas pedagogu sagatavošanu.
