

## Discussion around the key concepts

### Objectives:

- To become aware of our own definition of the key concepts involved in this workshop
- To consider other definitions of those same concepts
- To share those definitions so as to be able to build on them during the rationale presentation

### Materials

A Power Point presentation to show the general outline of the task and the activity at every time period.

### Sequence of activities

- Explanation of activities
- Base Group work
  - Each group meets (in the same room)
  - “Experts” are chosen to deal with the following concepts
    - Language
    - Culture
    - Communication
    - Diversity
    - Identity
  - Each person in the group must write a definition of those five concepts
  - The group shares the definitions and a consensus must be reached for a group definition of each
    - Each expert may study their concept and make a proposal of group definition
  - Each expert will take note of the group definition of their concept
- Expert Group Work
  - Experts will meet to exchange base group definitions
  - While two/three of those experts try to write a single definition of the concept using the base group definition
  - Two/three experts go to the resource centre to find more information about the concepts
    - Encyclopedia
    - Dictionaries
    - Internet
    - ...
  - Both groups meet again to write a single definition of each concept
  - They prepare a poster with the definition of the concept
- Expert group exhibition of the posters
