- 4) a. A teacher makes a first judgement of an oral interaction activity in order to generally estimate the level of the learners.
 - b.The same teacher proceeds to a second judgement with the help of some assessment tool.
- 5) A teacher prepares a grid which he/she gives to his/her students in order for them to become aware of their level.
