El Consell d'Europa va organitzar el taller titulat: Cap a un marc comú de referència per als professors de llengües, el 3-4 d'octubre al Centre europeu de llengües de Graz (Àustria).

L'objectiu d'aquest taller és definir les competències que han de tenir els professors de llengües i els professors de llengües que vehiculen en una llengua estrangera. Es concreten tres àmbits per classificar les competències: saber, saber fer i actituds. Les competències que s'estableixen estan estretament relacionades amb els valors i els principis del Consell d'Europa com són: promoure i respectar els drets humans, afavorir la cohesió social i la inclusió de tots aquells que aprenen, saber treballar en equip i participar activament en la societat de manera democràtica.

La intenció d'elaborar un marc europeu comú de referència prové d'una banda, de l'existència de diversos marcs establerts per institucions i associacions que donen informació diferent i de l'altra, de la necessitat de publicar una eina comuna per part d'una institució que representa als 47 països d'Europa.

L'ús del marc europeu comú de referència s'ha d'entendre com una eina que guia el professor per saber quines són les competències que hauria de tenir i que guia els autors de programes educatius de formació de professors per saber les directrius generals que han de tenir en compte. En cap cas, s'ha de llegir el marc com una llista exhaustiva que engloba totes les competències que ha de tenir obligatòriament un docent de llengües. Cada sistema educatiu europeu ha de tenir en compte les competències del marc europeu i adoptar les que millor s'adequen al seu país.
