Vaatamata suurele populaarsusele õpilaste seas, kasutatakse digivahendeid keeleõppes ikka veel tagasihoidlikult. ECMLi poolt läbi viidud projekti/töötoa *Digitaalne kirjaoskus keeleõppes ja õpetamise* eesmärgiks oli soodustada tehnoloogia kasutamist keeleõppes. Samuti oli eesmärgiks anda kasutajatele

abi tööriistade ja veebivahendite kriitiliseks kasutamiseks tagamaks suuremat autonoomiat ja laiapõhjalisemat tehnoloogia kasutust. Projektis osales üle 42 keeleõpetaja ning õpetajate koolitaja üle Euroopa ning pakkus suurepäraseid võimalusi mõtete ja kogemuste vahetamiseks kolleegidega.

Lisaks tehnoloogiaalaste teadmiste laiendamisele oli projekti taotluseks pöörata tähelepanu õppijate lingvistilistele ja interkultuurilistele oskuste ja teadmiste arendamisele. Rõhku pandi CEFRI põhimõtete rakendamisele kaasaegsete keeleõppemeetodite (nt aktiivõppemeetod, projektipõhine õpe jne) rakendamisel.

Projekti raames käsitletud täpsemad teemad olid järgmised:

- päriselu ülesanded (*real life tasks*) keeleõppes
- tehnoloogia ja grammatiline kompetents
- tehnoloogia kultuuridevahelises suhtluses
- tehnoloogia võimalused kirjaoskuste arendamiseks
- tehnoloogia võimalused kuulamisoskuse arendamiseks

**Projekti tulemusena peaks valmima projekti meeskonna poolt koostatud ning rahvusvaheliste ekspertide poolt üle vaadatud ülalmainitud teemasid hõlmav Moodle'i kursus, mis tehakse avalikult kättesaadavaks pärast lõplikku redigeerimist.**
