Brief summary of the content of the workshop	<p>The topic of the workshop was Digital Literacy for the Teaching and Learning of Languages and took place on 10-11 October at the European Centre for Modern Languages in Graz. The main objective of the workshop was to introduce recent development in using digital resources in teaching and learning languages, encourage students' autonomy via creating meaningful tasks that reflect real life situations and developing lifelong skills to improve students' professional and personal development. A new idea was the presentation of another skill – language as a means of mediation. The workshop offered a balanced input of plenary sessions and group work of participants on different modules aiming at the design of real-world tasks, their presentation and action plan how to implement them in language teaching and learning.</p>
What did you find particularly useful?	<p>The provision of the project's pedagogical framework and the different aspects that should be borne in mind when using digital tools and resources, the opportunity to meet professionals engaged in different areas of education and the cooperation on the design of the tasks, the creation of a network to foster future work on common projects and to involve language learners in real life communication with learners from other countries, the opportunity to share experience and ideas with other teachers, educators</p>
How will you use what you learnt / developed in the event in your professional context?	<p>I will try to incorporate the new ideas that fit into my teaching context as much as possible, get acquainted with new tools that might be more motivating for my students and share what I have learnt with colleagues from the English department, the Germanic and Romance department, suggest ideas for the implementation of useful digital tools in our teaching environment to authorities.</p>

Workshop sa konal v dňoch 10.-11. októbra 2017 v Grazi v Centre pre moderne jazyky a bol sponzorovaný Radou Európy. Cieľovou skupinou boli zamestnanci štátnej správy v oblasti školstva, v oblasti vzdelávania dospelých, školitelia, riaditelia škôl, učitelia 2. a 3.stupňa. Účastníci boli nominovaní Ministerstvom školstva v pozvaných krajinách a celkovo zastupovali 34 krajín sveta.

Workshop bol zameraný na digitálnu gramotnosť a využitie digitálnych nástrojov a zdrojov vo výučbe cudzích jazykov. Je súčasťou e-lang-ového projektu Centra, ktorý spolu s rovnomennou pripravovanou publikáciou má slúžiť ako návod na využitie týchto prostriedkov s dôrazom na sociálnu interakciu a vytváraním úloh a situácií, ktoré reflektujú reálny život. Ďalšou prioritou je pomocou týchto prostriedkov podporovať a motivovať učiacich sa, aby zodpovedne a samostatne vedeli používať vedomosti, zručnosti a postoje v osobnom a profesionálnom kontexte.

Workshop prebiehal formou plenárnych zasadnutí, v rámci ktorých zamestnanci Centra predstavili Centrum pre moderne jazyky a ich vízie pre budúci vývoj jazykovej výučby a práce v menších skupinách, počas ktorej účastníci mohli navrhnúť konkrétne úlohy na implementáciu digitálnych technológií s podnetom na reálnu komunikáciu. Skupiny pracovali na niekoľkých moduloch (rozvoj kultúrneho povedomia formou korešpondencie medzi študentmi - [http://www.studentsoftheworld.info/menu\\_penpals.php](http://www.studentsoftheworld.info/menu_penpals.php), príprava tutorialu k pracovnému pohovoru, príprava vlastného kanálu na Utube a vlogu, [www.poetrynation.com](http://www.poetrynation.com)- čítanie a komentár k básňam na rozvoj kritického myslenia a tvorba vlastných básní, využitie Audacity, Instagram alebo padlet na vytvorenie reálnych úloh), následne každá skupina prezentovala nimi vypracované úlohy a počas voľnej diskusie účastníci mali možnosť sa vyjadriť k potenciálnemu využitiu materiálov v svojom pracovnom

kontexte. Na záver workshopu účastníci spolu vytvorili databázu k ďalšej spolupráci v rámci spomínaného projektu a medzi jednotlivými inštitúciami podľa oblasti ich záujmu.
