Projekt „Razvoj svijesti o jeziku u pojedinim predmetima“ jedan je od projekata koje Europski centar za moderne jezike provodi u periodu od 2016. do 2019. godine, u periodu posvećenom jezicima kao okosnici učenja i usvajanja novih znanja. Projekt polazi od ideje da je za uspjeh u učenju neophodno dobro poznavanje jezika koji se uglavnom razlikuje od jezika kakav se koristi u svakodnevnoj komunikaciji tj. neakademsom okruženju. Materijali su prvenstveno namijenjeni nastavnicima matematike, prirodnih predmeta i povijesti koji poučavaju u višim razredima osnovne škole, a obuhvaćaju primjere metoda za pružanje podrške učenicima s nedovoljnim poznavanjem jezika.
