Brief summary of the content of the workshop	The workshop was well-organized, as it started with pre- workshop activities and performing background reading 'Digital Literacy for The Teaching And Learning of Language: Towards A Socio-Interactional Approach to Foster Autonomy in Language Learners and Users', which clarified adopted terminology, defined 'real-world task' and demonstrated their significance and advantages in language learning and teaching. The workshop aimed to combine tasks and the use of digital resources for learners to develop both lifelong skills and a stronger autonomy and personal learning experience, which requires awareness of digital resources, knowledge of using these resources and assessment of their potential for language teaching and learning. What was more valuable for me was the presentation of the online modules and the integration of the strategies and/or resources presented in the modules into the real-world tasks developed by the groups. The online modules were aimed at developing strategies on how to build different skills such as aural reception, written reception, oral production etc based on digital resources.	





What did you find particularly useful?	The feedback to online modules, as well as group discussions were of utmost importance for me, as I enjoyed a unique opportunity of communicating with people having different backgrounds, expertise, sharing ideas and experiences of applying digital resources in language teaching and learning. Besides I explored two more extremely useful ECML websites, which should comprise an integral part of each English teacher's professional life: Developing Online Teaching Skills http://dots.ecml.at/ and Inventory of ICT tools and open educational resources http://ict-rev.ecml.at/en-us/Resources/Inventory-of-ICT-tools-and- OERs which present step-by-step guidance on how to smoothly and flawlessly integrate technologies in teaching English. These are invaluable resources for further examination and exploration.
How will you use what you learnt / developed in the event in your professional context?	I will conduct a training for the language teachers from the Department of Foreign Languages of ISEC NAS RA to share with the resources, knowledge and experience I have gained from this workshop. During the training I will disseminate the flyers of Developing Online Teaching Skills http://dots.ecml.at/ and Inventory of ICT tools and open educational resources http://ict-rev.ecml.at/en-us/Resources/Inventory-of-ICT-tools- and-OERs for the further exploration and investigation of ISEC teachers.

As all the workshop participants are on Moodle, we will continue discussing and giving feedback to online modules as required, as perform any other activities as requested by the project coordinators.
