

Assessment

Formative assessment

- Feedback, teacher assessment in the classroom, or home works (homemade videos in sign language) correction and assessment
- Self-assessment
- Via tasks in the class and at home

Exam is at the end of the course. Level-closing exam, with fixed duration, objective.

Assessment of the language knowledge:

- Proficiency (skill-level) Scale
- Examination Rating Scale (pass or 3 point; a very weak performance = 1, an excellent performance =5)
- Achievement assessment
- Proficiency assessment

Overall Comprehension:

- Can understand the main ideas of propositionally and linguistically complex texts on both concrete and abstract topics delivered in a standard dialect;
- Can keep up with an animated conversation between native signers.

Production

- Can interact with a degree of fluency and spontaneity that makes regular interaction with native speakers quite possible without imposing strain on either party;
- Can support its opinion with argument and can communicate the advantages and disadvantages of a theme;
- Can communicate the different grades of the senses and can pass on the information sensitive.

Lexical competence

- Its sign-vocabulary nears to the sign-vocabulary of a native signers with average literacy;

Grammatical Competence

- Can create a correct grammatical communication;
- Can use the sign language without misunderstanding;
- Can repair its faults easily;

Communicative value

- The daily conversation does not disengage;
- Can recognize the special communicative needs of its partner and can sign according to this;
