It provided them with learning and teaching resources and strategies which take existing linguistic repertoires into account in order to (further) develop the linguistic and intercultural competences of both learners and educators.

Ms Déirdre Kirwan's presentation of integrated approach to early language learning in primary school, developed in 1990s in Ireland (for example; pupils were allowed to read their homework in their native language, it was clearly outlined that even if there is only one pupil speaking different language, his/her language is as important as any other; etc.)

Izvještaj o Radionici Evropskog centra za savremene jezike (ECML) "Inspirativno učenje i podučavanje jezika u ranim godinama. Zašto je to bitno i kako to izgleda za djecu uzrasta 3-12 godina"

Austrija, Graz, 12-13. 9. 2018. godine

Radionica je održana u sjedištu Evropskog centra za savremene jezike pod pokroviteljstvom Vijeća Evrope. Radionici su prisustvovala 44 učesnika iz 33 države članice ECML-a. Pored Bosne i Hercegovine, slijedeće države su bile zastupljene: Albanija, Armenija, Austrija, Belgija, Bugarska, Danska, Kanada, Hrvatska, Holandija, Kipar, Češka, Estonija, Finska, Francuska, Njemačka, Grčka, Island, Irska, Latvija, Litvanija, Luksemburg, Malta, Crna Gora, Norveška, Poljska, Rumunija, Srbija, Slovačka, Slovenija, Švedska, Ujedinjeno Kraljevstvo, Holandija i Makedonija.

Radionica je namijenjena nastavnicima, trenerima, inspektorima, donosiocima odluka u obrazovnoj politici i naučnim radnicima.

Cilj radionice je ukazivanje na pozitivne aspekte učenja stranih jezika u ranoj dobi (3-12) i upoznavanje sa konceptima i materijalima koji doprinose inspirativnom učenju jezika u ranoj dobi.

Tokom radionice, učesnici su imali priliku upoznati se sa ECML-ovim resursima za učenje stranih jezika u ranoj dobi. Prezentirane su ideje i inovativne prakse koje se koriste u procesu savladavanja stranih jezika u raznim državama članicama ECML-a, kao i razni pristupi koji omogućavaju bolju interakciju između nastavnika i učenika. Razgovaralo se o stvaranju zajedničkog razumijevanja principa i pristupa koji doprinose inspirativnom učenju i podučavanju jezika u ranoj dobi i o tome na koji način i u kojoj mjeri postojeći lingvistički repertoar učenika može doprinijeti učenju stranih jezika.
