12. i 13. septembra 2018. godine u Evropskom centru za moderne jezike u Grazu, Austrija, realizovan je dvodnevni seminar na temu “Inspiring language learning and teaching in the early years: Why it matters and what it looks like for children aged 3-12 years”. Seminar je okupio edukatore i nastavnike iz 32 zemlje koji su imali priliku da podijele iskustva o značaju učenja estranog jezika na ranom uzrastu i značaju plurilingvizma u savremenom društvu.

Tokom dvodnevnog intezivnog rada predstavljen je rad Evropskog centra za moderne jezike, kao i njihov web sajt ([www.ecml.at](http://www.ecml.at)) koji predstavlja izuzetno važan izvor za nastavnike stranih jezika. Predstavljen je projekat “Inspiring language learning and teaching in the early years” kojim su se poslednjih godinu dana bavili edukatori iz pet različitih zemalja.

Poseban osvrt je dat na prednosti i izazove sa kojima se edukatori suočavaju prilikom učenja i podučavanja stranih jezika u svojim kontekstima. Učesnici su imali priliku da definišu osnovna načela učenja i podučavanja jezika na ranom uzrastu, kao i da se upoznaju sa web sajtom koji je izrađen tokom trajanja projekta (<https://www.ecml.at/ECML-Programme/Programme2016-2019/Inspiringlanguagelearningintheearlyyears/Overview/tabid/3057/language/en-GB/Default.aspx>), koji može poslužiti kao odličan izvor nastavnicima koji rade sa djecom ovog uzrasta. Veoma važan segment radionica je bio i dio gdje su učesnici imali priliku da prezentuju projekte i podijele iskustva i izvore koje koriste u svojim zemljama za podučavanje stranih jezika na uzrastu od 3 do 12 godina.
