Radionica Europskog centra za suvremene jezike Vijeća Europe na temu razvijanja nastavničkih kompetencija za primjenu višejezičnih pristupa bila je sjajna prilika za upoznavanje stručnjaka koji se bave promidžbom višejezičnosti i višekulturnosti te za razmjenu ideja. Ovo je iskustvo izrodilo suradnju nekolicine kolega koji će se, u nastavku ovog projekta, baviti razvijanjem deskriptora za metajezičnu kompetenciju nastavnika stranih jezika.

S obzirom na to da je poznavanje stranih jezika jedna od ključnih kompetencija građanina 21. stoljeća, stvaranje profesionalnih mreža i kontakata u svrhu bolje edukacije nastavnika jedini je ispravni put kojim i ECML stremi ostvariti svoje ciljeve. Promjena paradigme u poučavanju isključiva je odgovornost jezične politike, razvoja kurikuluma, a potom i nastavnika stranih jezika koji, prema Sočanac (2013), trebaju biti primjer europskih vrijednosti otvorenosti prema drugima, tolerancije prema različitostima i spremnosti na komunikaciju. Uz postojeće dokumente Vijeća Europe, dokument sa smjernicama i deskriptorima, razvijen suradnjom vodećih stručnjaka iz područja jezičnog obrazovanja i baziran na najrecentnijim rezultatima istraživanjima, bio bi uistinu dragocjen i nezamjenjiv alat za planiranje i ostvarenje razvoja kompetencija nastavnika stranih jezika.
