Brief summary of the content of the workshop	The content of the workshop was arranged in three main modules: (1) Concepts and frameworks, (2) Taking stock of transversal competences in European education and (3) Moving forward with TC in language education. The 1 st module included an overview of various existing competence frameworks and the relations between transversal competences and language education. The 2 nd module provided opportunities to learn about the solutions applied in current educational policies of different countries and examples of good practice from the classrooms. The 3 rd module provided space for discussing challenges and solutions connected with incorporating transversal competences into language education and gathering ideas for follow-up projects.
What did you find particularly useful?	Each of the above mentioned modules had its value for me. I especially treasure the overview of educational policy and practice in incorporating transversal competences in language education in different countries.
How will you use what you learnt / developed in the event in your professional context?	At the moment I am working on the in-service teacher training offer of Centrum Edukacji Nauczycieli for school year 2022/2023 and I intend to prepare some training sessions connected with the topic of incorporating transversal competences in foreign language education. In a teachers' network which I coordinate we have already decided to focus on this subject in October this year. I would like to discuss TC during one of the events organised by IATEFL PL next school year and prepare an article about transversal competences in language education.
