Brief summary of the content of the workshop	27 participants from ECML member states discussed on chapters regarding Manual for teachers, educators and stakeholders on language education in cross-border regions. Participants suggested ideas, exchanged experiences and made contributions themselves. During the discussions, the importance of languages and plurilingual/intercultural competences in vocational training and cross-border working environments was emphasized and at the same time time, new ideas for implementation and conduction was born among teachers.
What did you find particularly useful?	Sharing thoughts and ideas with teacher colleagues and their practices in different countries and border regions, especially practices regarding teaching in bilingual environments.
How will you use what you learnt / developed in the event in your professional context?	I will organize bilingual classes with my bilingual students and incorporate CLIL, where students will have opportunity to compare cultures and value language learning and plurilingualism. I will present about it on ELTAM (English language Teachers' Association of Montenegro) conference.
How will you further contribute to the project?	By being informed and follow the future development of the project and the Manual and finding appropriate ways to get involved.
