Brief summary of the content of the workshop	The project aims to strengthen language learning, language understanding (intercomprehension) and intercultural competencies across borders, especially in neighbouring countries such as Germany and France; Czech Republic and Poland, Latvia and Lithuania etc. The intersection of language education and vocational training is a field with little research where more knowledge is needed, especially with increasing demand for transversal skills across all the sectors of the labour market. The objectives of the workshop were (in my perspective) to provide the space for knowledge exchange and networking as well as lay the groundwork for the development of guidelines and training modules for plurilingual and intercultural teaching and learning.
What did you find particularly useful?	 The opportunity to meet educators from many European countries (and Canada) and learn about how the vocational education works there and compare it to the Norwegian system. Learning about the cross-border mobility programs in neighbouring regions. Learning about the notion of intercomprehension.
How will you use what you learnt / developed in the event in your professional context?	As I'm particularly interested in the second language acquisition of late arrived students with migrant background, I find the project to be very interesting and of social importance. As a teacher educator I see a strong need for an intercultural pedagogy in the VET-field as well as general guidelines for good language learning and teaching strategies that also VET-teachers could





	use. From the CLIL perspective I believe that language learning should not be restricted to the language classes as this is neither where students spend the most time nor have the biggest motivation for. I hope that the manual developed as a result of the project can be used as a resource in educating VET-teachers as well as that it will increase awareness of the language education in vocational training.
How will you further contribute to the project?	I might enrol in a follow-up workshop on the same topic if such an opportunity arises and contribute with my perspectives there.
