Brief summary of the content of the workshop	The project aims to make early language learning in educational contexts visible through a range of methods and tools. These make it possible to identify, understand and document language learning of children age 3 to 12 and thereby create learning opportunities allowing them to progress along their language learning pathways. Based on this, during the meeting, the topics of documentation, observation and assessment were considered in detail. Working in groups with colleagues from other countries helped to get acquainted with their experience in this area. Understanding that every teacher is a language teacher is a challenge in many countries, it is necessary to spread this understanding.
What did you find particularly useful?	In addition to the acquired knowledge, it was very useful to communicate with colleagues from different countries and exchange experience on this topic.
How will you use what you learnt / developed in the event in your professional context?	At the moment, a seminar is already planned, where, together with other colleagues from Estonia who have attended ECML. It will be discussed the possibilities of using the acquired knowledge and experience for the benefit of education in Estonia. There is a plan to acquaint the participants of the pilot project „Professional teacher of the Estonian language in preschool institutions with the Russian language of instruction and in the 1st, 2nd grades of basic school“ with this topic, to include this topic in the teaching within the framework of this project.

<p>How will you further contribute to the project?</p>	<p>I think that spreading the knowledge gained at the project meeting and finding application opportunities in Estonia and feedback on the work done is already a great contribution to the project.</p>
<p>How do you plan to disseminate the project?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - to colleagues - to a professional association - in a professional journal/website - in a newspaper - other 	<p>We exchange information with colleagues at weekly info hours and seminars of the department. We already support the specialists from Tallinn University, within the framework of the program, the lecturers get acquainted with the experience of different countries, including ECML projects for advanced training and competence formation. We will discuss the possibility of covering the topic in the media at the upcoming seminar about which I wrote above.</p>

<p>Projekt Palingui – Laste keeleõppe teed – Varajase keeleõppre nähtavaks tegemine (<i>PALINGUI – Language learning pathways of young children – Making early language learning visible</i>) on osa ECML programmidest “Innustav uuendus keeleõppes: muutuv kontekst, arenevad pädevused” (“<i>Inspiring innovation in language education: changing contexts, evolving competences</i>”). Selle eesmärgiks on muuta varajane keeleõpe hariduslikus kontekstis nähtavaks mitmesuguste meetodite ja vahendite kaudu. Need võimaldavad tuvastada, mõista ja dokumenteerida 3–12-aastaste laste keeleõpet ning seeläbi luua õppimisvõimalusi, mis võimaldavad neil oma keeleõpperadadel edasi liikuda. Vaatlus, hindamine ja dokumenteerimine kui õppimise lahutamatu osa ja õppimise visualiseerimine on projekti võtmeeks. Selles tulenevalt keskendub projekt klassiruumis toimuva vaatluse erinevatele vormidele ja laste õppimise dokumenteerimise viisidele ning hindamise põhimõõtmetele, nt. hindamine õppimiseks, hindamine kui õppimine ja õppimise hindamine (sh kujundav hindamine, enesehindamine ja kaaslaste hindamine). Projektis mängib olulist rolli kogemuste vahetamine, mõtete jagamine ning keeleõppre vaatlemise, hindamise ja dokumenteerimisega seotud ideede arutamine. Selleks on projekt kaasatud eksperdid paljudest Euroopa Nõukogu liikmesriikidest. Hetkel on projekt lõpusirgel. Arvestades Eesti haridussüsteemi hetkeolukorda ning seoses eestikeelsele õppele üleminnekuga on tähtis tutvustada projekti laiemalt erinevatele sihtrühmadele ja mõelda koos oma parimate teadmiste, oskuste ja praktikate struktureerimisest/süstematiserimisest, täiendamisest ning süsteemsest kasutamisest.</p> <p>Haridus- ja varajase keeleõppre valdkonna ekspertidele (sh keeleteadlased, koolitajad, õpetajad) annab see võimaluse:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - saada teadlikuks noore õppija olemaolevast keelelisest potentsiaalist (sealhulgas koolikeel(ed), piirkondlik, vähemus-, võõr- ja kodukeel(ed)); 	

- arendada laiemat vaadet/sügavamat arusaama keeleõppest, tunnustades eelnevalt õpitut, lõimides keeleõpet üle õppekava, arvestades laste ja vanemate vaatenurki;
- kasutada õppijakeskseid protsesse ja strateegiaid (nt erinevat tüüpi hindamine ja dokumentatsioon) ning luua õppimisvõimalusi, mis põhinevad väikelaste individuaalsel potentsiaalil, huvidel ja vajadustel;
- saada teada erinevaid keeleõppe dokumenteerimise viise (nt meetodid, vahendid);
- teha kaalutletud valikuid ja kohandada viise antud hariduskonteksti eripäradega;
- käsitleda keeleõpet kui protsessi ja vigu selle protsessi osana ning järelikult kasutada neid õppimisvõimaluste loomiseks;
- mõtiskleda isiklike hoiakute/uskumuste üle mitmekeelsuse ja keeleõpppe kohta.

See kõik aitab nooremas vanuses keeleõppijatel:

- teadvustada oma olemasolevat keelelist potentsiaali, milles on nad head on ja kus saavad veel paremini hakkama;
- teha kindlaks, kust nad oma õpiteel on/on tulnud; kuhu nad lähevad; kuidas nad sinna jõuavad;
- õppida kasutama oma keelelist potentsiaali järgmiste sammude saavutamiseks.

Samad põhimõtted on fookuses pilootprojektis „Professionaalne eestikeelne õpetaja haridasutuses“, neid tuleb vaid tervikuna projekti sihtrühmadele tutvustada ning rakendada terviklikult. Samuti on ootus, et koos teiste ECMLi projektidest osa võtnud kolleegidega korraldatud seminari raames leiame võimaluse, kuidas paremini kasutada rahvusvaheliste projektide kogemusi/tulemusi Eestis.
