CONTENT	Creating a film either recording moving pictures or still pictures. Adding sounds (music and/or speaking voice) and subtitles. Use either authentic pictures such as photos or fantasy pictures to the theme.

The presentation of the films and reading the manuscript of the films. Formative evaluation is given along the way.		I always let my students evaluate my courses at the end of every semester. In almost every evaluation my students write that they liked the film making the most and want to do it more. The students are involved and working with the project outside of school.

## ADDED VALUE

(Increase in value created by the use of the ICT tool)

Making films is engaging for pupils and it is also a good way to get them to practice their presentation more than once. If they know that they are going to record their presentation, they tend to want to know it by heart. This results in getting the target words into their active vocabulary.
