Brief summary of the content of the workshop	<p>We got information about the ECML including its activities, about the whole content of the project, we discussed the language education in various countries.</p> <p>The new programme builds on the Centre's previous work and widens its scope to move beyond the foreign language classroom to include all linguistic abilities and the needs of all groups of learners.</p> <p>Within this context language(s) represent(s) the principal medium through which learning is achieved, so the programme will address not just the foreign language classroom but the teaching of the language of schooling, of other languages present in the educational environment and the languages used in subject teaching.</p>
What did you find particularly useful?	<p>A lot of new information, interesting discussions, Plurilingualism in teacher education etc.</p> <p>The project will focus on teacher education for the majority language (e.g. French in France, Polish in Poland). It aims to provide access to</p>

	plurilingual approaches so that teachers can address and build on linguistic and cultural diversity in classrooms. The project will also promote collaboration between teachers of all languages.

Ve dnech 14. a 15. února 2013 se uskutečnil v Grazu v Rakousku odborný workshop, jehož pořadatelem bylo Evropské středisko pro cizí jazyky (ECML, www.ecml.at) v rámci realizace projektu Diversity in majority language learning (Sprachliche und kulturelle Vielfalt im Unterricht der Mehrheitssprache).

Workshop vedli členové projektového týmu ve složení Eija Aalto, Andrea Abel, Katja Schnitzer, Nathalie

Auger, Dagmar Gilly .

Na workshopu se sešlo 32 účastníků z 21 zemí Evropské unie, a to učitelů a odborníků specializovaných na výuku mateřského jazyka ve školách, v nichž plní žáci povinnou školní docházku.

V průběhu dvoudenního semináře byli účastníci vyzváni, aby sdíleli a porovnávali cíle vzdělávání dané kurikulem svých zemí a diskutovali o prvcích vícejazyčnosti v něm obsažených. Současný stav vývoje projektu Maledive byl co podrobněji popsán a byly představeny studijní moduly, zejména modul na řízení diverzity většinového jazyka (ML). Účastníci byli vyzváni, aby se k němu vyjádřili a dále rozvíjeli práci v týmu. Vedli jsme živou diskusi o klíčových výzvách ve výuce většinového jazyka: jak zařídit, změnu v myšlení od jednojazyčnosti k vícejazyčnosti? A ještě před tím, jak přesvědčit učitele o potřebě změny?

Část semináře byla věnována dalším souvisejícím ESMJ projektům, jako PlurCur , CARAP / Frepa a CLIL.

Závěr semináře se zabýval možnostmi budoucí spolupráce.

Celý průběh, organizace a realizace workshopu byl velmi užitečný a podnětný. Seznámili jsme se s novými nápady a pracovními metodami. V budoucnu se budeme snažit zaměřit více přímo na jádro ML výuky a potřeby učitelů. Toho bude dosaženo zvýšením počtu místních aktivit, vytvářením výzkumných projektů a využitím webových stránek ke vzdělávání učitelů.
