On some issues of school education of Ukrainian children who left Ukraine

According to the legislation of the respective countries, children from Ukraine can be enrolled in the general secondary education institutions of the host countries at the request of their parents. This shall enable students to continue their education.

At the initiative of non-governmental organizations of Ukrainians in some countries with the assistance of educational and local authorities of these countries there may be organized separate institutions and classes for migrants with training conducted according to the state standards and educational programs of Ukraine. Educational documents in such cases will be issued by the International Ukrainian School or any other general secondary education institution of Ukraine with which Ukrainian public organizations and/or educational institutions of the host countries have or will have relevant agreements on assistance to Ukrainian children. All students must be enrolled to the International Ukrainian School or another educational institution in the manner prescribed by the legislation of Ukraine.

If a school where children studied in Ukraine has already organized distance learning, it is necessary to recommend students to join this process, it will be the most desirable, and best in psychological aspect. In this case, parents should contact their institution.

Parents can also apply to the International Ukrainian School for enrollment to the school on individual basis. The necessary information is posted on the school's website: <u>https://uis.org.ua</u>

In all cases, children can use any online resources for group or individual work, first of all the Ukrainian School Online (<u>https://lms.e-school.net.ua</u>, there is also a mobile application), that has all educational materials for students of grades 1-11.

The International Ukrainian School of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine has also prepared independent programs, which include links to electronic textbooks and didactic/multimedia materials. Klim Churyumov Science Lyceum has opened <u>registration</u> for online lessons and regular daily meetings of children with psychologists. The program gives children the opportunity to listen to school curricula, popular science lectures, author courses from scientists, artists, interesting interactive non-formal education courses, and join language clubs.
