
3. Professional background / Parcours professionnel:

I am a teacher of English at a secondary school. I have been teaching English for 28 years and I am an English & French graduate of the University of Bucharest. I am the Head of the Foreign Languages Department in our school. I am teaching my students not only the English language but I also focus on the English civilisation and culture. I attended professional trainings in my country and also, abroad through the Pestalozzi Programme and the Comenius Lifelong Learning Programme . I have always been interested in learning new ways of motivating my students to study foreign languages

 - 1. I was the European coordinator of the Comenius school project « Discover each other and create together » between 2004-2007. Our partners were :College « La Ville-aux-Roses », Chateaubriant, France ;Volkschulle Bischbrunn, Germany ;Zakladna Skola Stanicna 13, Kosice, Slovakia. The main objectives of our project were :
 - Promoting the national culture, history and civilisation of each partner country;



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- Developing tolerance, acceptance and integration of the minority groups in each partner country;
- Discovery of the great variety of regional identities within Europe and the creation of a European identity throughout history;
- Developing the relationships between generations by transmitting the traditions, legends and myths;
- Developing the relationships among all the educational factors: the teaching staff, the management board, the pupils, the parents, the local authorities.

During the development of the project I worked together with the history teachers, the art and music teachers from my school and from the European partner schools and our pupils created1) a glossary of everyday words and phrases in the four languages of the countries involved in the project with an English translation; 2)a book with traditional legends and myths; 3)a glossary of legendary characters; 4) an original European legend in which the characters were legendary characters from the four countries.

- 2. I was a methodologist for the International Programmes and Projects Department of the School Inspectorate of Bucharest for two years: 2004-2005 and 2008-2009. In this quality, I had to monitor and give support to all the project coordinators in my sector of Bucharest.
- 3. Between 2008-2010, I was the Coordinator of the Programmes and Projects Commission in my school and I organised activities dedicated to European events :9th May, Spring Day in Europe, European Language Day, the Comenius Weeks etc.
- 4. During almost twenty years of my teaching career I had to teach minority students and students from disadvantaged families(with social and financial problems). I have always involved them in the school projects in order to help them to get self-esteem and develop their talents.
- 5. As a teacher of English, I prepared my students for the Cambridge exams from the early stages and I encouraged them to take part in a lot of competitions in which they obtained very good results.
- 6. Since 2003 I have also been teaching the Reading Module at the English Centre of Excellence for the pupils of sector 5, Bucharest. My work there is voluntary and the aim of this Centre of Excellence is to provide students with very good results in the English Language study, but most of them from disadvantaged families, with further knowledge and information necessary for their future exams and careers.
- 7. In 2011, I started a school project « The Reading Corner » . The aim of the project is to raise the pupils'motivation for reading books. Students read a book of their choice from the books I bought for them and then, in groups, talk about the characters, write summaries, make posters with their drawings representing scenes from the book etc.
